In the midst of the digital revolution and the development of biotechnologies, humanity is at a turning point in which ethical questions take center stage.The exhibition's inventive and humorous museography, combined with immersive and creative staging, are designed to question our own limits... and beyond!

FIRST PART I'M AN EXCEPTIONAL ANIMAL





The introduction examines «what is specifically human» while the first part launches into the controversy of whether man is an animal like other animals. Three different types of devices invite viewers to question our so-called human exception: a contemporary hybrid work, a large audiovisual installation placing visitors at the heart of a citizen debate, and a video montage illustrating the astonishing capacities of certain animals.



SECOND PART I'M A CHAMPION





The next part looks at the performances of the human body. Physical and mental training, creativity, nd technical innovation allow athletes to surpass their former limits. A large installation, representing Dick Fosbury's high jump welcomes the public. One-way mirrors enable visitors to compare their own physique with those of the great champions, while three videos trace the invention of ground breaking techniques in sports.



THIRD PART I'M A CYBORG






Today, technology makes it possible for almost anyone to transcend his or her body's limits via prostheses, exoskeletons, implants, connected objects, etc. A futuristic setting plunges visitors into the imaginary world of human machines and into the reality of technological innovations. A presentation of objects, images, film extracts and artists' performances illustrates the great diversity of devices associated with the "hybrid human".



FOURTH PART I'M A MUTANT





In a laboratory-like setting, visitors can take three tracks to explore biological and genetic advances, their impact on human beings and the ethical questions they raise. They include a staggering contemporary work, a game to conceive an ideal baby, and a wall of information. The latter offers, in contrast, an accurate vision of scientific, economic, and political reality.

Mixing ethnographic objects, contemporary art, folk art, a large interactive wall and and a comical film, the following part of the exhibition probes both humanity's historical quest for immortality, as well as one of its recent excesses: transhumanism.



SIXTH PART WE'RE ALL GOING TO DIE!





The final part approaches humanity as a whole, rather than as the individual and lists the dangers that threaten our species. Visitors are returned to the reality of a planet in such terrible condition that its future appears uncertain. As an epilogue, surround sound stories adopt an offbeat and amusing tone to imagine the life choices of tomorrow's humans.
