Experience the D-Day landing through the eyes of paratroopers who liberated Sainte-Mère-Eglise with D-Day: Freedom from Above the Augmented Exhibition. Using an interactive tablet, the HistoPad, visitors explore interactive 3D recreations of 14 key moments and places of the Sainte-Mère-Eglise battle including the 82nd and 101st Airborne briefing on June 4th, the parachute jump into the village, the battle at Pont de la Fière, and even a military field hospital at La Colombière. The interactive components allow visitors to manipulate gear, tools and weapons, meet key figures, and watch real archival footage.
